They have agreed to repair the parts of the Bradley Hills park fence that are coming down, add benches by the trees, extend the fence further across Madison and resurface the tennis courts and add new benches across from the court. They agreed that the school landscape plan does not provide enough screening and will look into evergreen trees.
